#### Russia's invasion of Ukraine

Unfortunately, a lot has happened in the world since the last Impact of the Month. Linköping University took an early and strong stance against Russia's invasion of Ukraine, something that we in the Consensus viewed very positively. In the first days after the invasion, a lot happened at the university and a special working group was appointed to monitor the situation, which is in constant dialogue with student unions. Consensus also participated, together with crisis management and other employees, in a workshop on continuity management where Consensus, among other things, contributed with opinions on the university's communication, student health priorities and the university's continued international activities. Several students, student associations and groups have also contacted us regarding help with pursuing questions, spreading information and getting in touch with the right people at the university. ## No one should have to pay for VFU

Hidden travel- and accommodation costs in connection with work-based education (VFU) is something that has been on the table for Consensus, and many other student unions, for many years and we felt that it was time to pursue this issue properly. However, many of our programs have limited financial resources, which means that increased costs for the programs can empty out and, in the worst case, lower the quality of our education. We have therefore chosen to pursue this issue nationally. During March, Consensus therefore proposed to the SFS's that the government should appoint an inquiry to review the possibilities for financial support for VFU students. One solution that we believe the government should review is a CSN-administered grant for students who do VFU in a city other than their place of study. If this is not possible for various reasons, we believe that the government should compensate the programs with extra funds that can cover these costs for students. No student should have to pay for their education. A decision on SFS's business plan will be made on 8th of May.

## One website with information for student

As most of you might know, the current information flow to students is split on several different websites. Except for Lisam students can find information at the general page <u>student.liu.se</u>, medfak specific information at <u>old.liu.se/medfak</u> and other information at the old page insidan. The unstructured distribution of information has led to confusion among a lot of students and we in the student union have for a long time raised the need to merge all the into one joint platform. The Vice Chancellor and the university's director of internationalization have now approved one of our demands that the university should create an overall action plan for the coming years on how we should address this issue. During March, Consensus held a first workshop on creating this action plan with participating international students from all faculties and key people from LiU's international departments. Now, a first draft of the action plan will be completed before Easter in order to hopefully enable a decision before the summer. # Better study related support to students

Our students, unlike other students at Linköpings university, are continuously facing the challenge of passing their exams in order to continue to the next semester. Many students express that there is one semester employees called LiUnet, to argue together with the other student unions for a similar project for students.

The student unions received, along with the project group, the green light from the vice chancellor. The funding for a new sharepoint-platform with all necessary information for students have been decided. that is more difficult than the rest. In order to increase the amount of students managing to finish their degree, the vice-chancellor has put aside 9 million SEK for course development, and almost 1,5 million SEK will be directed specifically to medfak. Students have for a long time pointed out issues at the nurse and the speech therapist program and these programs will now, thanks to your feedback, use this money to implement new teaching methods during the first semesters. Our hope is that it will be easier for both students and the program to adapt the support to the individual needs of each student to improve their ability to pass the courses.
